We are happy to announce that for the Summer of 2008 all Memphis Montessori Institute (MMI) classes will be conducted at Lamplighter Montessori School, 8563 Fay Rd., Cordova, TN. Individual components of the total MMI certification program are listed below and priced separately. The entire certification program is less expensive than taking individual components.

Summer 2007 Tuition Schedule

Philosophy & History 8:00 – 5:00 M-F (40 clock hours) **June 09– June 13** \$600.00
Montessori Education is placed in historical perspective. Philosophy specific to the method and its relationship to the child, materials, teacher, and environment are explored.

Child Development 8:00 - 5:00 M-F (40 clock hours) **June 16 – June 20** \$600.00
Theories, stages, and areas of development are explored and current research is related to Montessori curriculum.

Practical Life 8:00 – 5:00 M-F (40 clock hours) **June 23– June 27** \$600.00
This course includes philosophy and rationale, ground rules, grace and courtesy, control of movement, care of the person, care of the environment, food preparation, and nutrition.

Sensorial/Science 8:00 – 5:00 M-F (40 clock hours) **July 7– July 11** \$600.00
The philosophy and rationale and the materials necessary to aid in the development and refinement of the senses and scientific knowledge are explored in this class.

Math 8:00 – 5:00 M-F (40 clock hours) **July 14 – July 18** \$600.00
This course includes philosophy and rationale and materials that aid in the development of the mathematical mind.

Language 8:00 – 5:00 M-F (40 clock hours) **July 21 – July 25** \$600.00
This course explores the philosophy and rationale, materials that aid visual and auditory perception, vocabulary, and the Montessori materials that are useful in developing language skills and reading.

Classroom Management 8:00 – 5:00 M-F (40 clock hours) **July 28– August 1** \$600.00
This class presents observation, preparation of the environment, scheduling and curriculum planning, assessment and communications techniques.

Fall 2-day Seminar

Advanced Materials (10 clock hours) \$45.00

Geography/Cultural Studies (10 clock hours) \$45.00

These seminars introduce students to activities and materials appropriate for the support of cultural awareness in young children and reinforce lessons with advanced materials.

Spring 2-day Seminar

Advanced Materials (10 clock hours) \$45.00

Music and Art (10 clock hours) \$45.00

These seminars introduce students to music concepts and reinforce lessons with advanced materials.

The complete teacher certification program that includes a year of internship and supervision plus two 2-day seminars in music, cultural subjects, and advanced materials is \$4,025. This fee includes a \$100 application fee, which is due with the application, for all students regardless of status. Students are also responsible for AMS and MACTE fees which are currently \$115 and \$125 respectively/ MMI practices a non-discriminatory admissions policy.

Components of the Summer Phase may be taken separately and each component may be paid for separately. Albums for each component must be purchased by the student at a cost of \$35 per album (total for all albums \$175). The student should budget for personal supplies, Montessori books, protector sheets for albums, photography, and three-ring binders.

Many schools offer assistance for certification and training costs in order to have students as assistants to lead teachers.
